The Centre for Criminology & Victimology has been given a Project from Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India to research on "Evaluation of functioning of Fast Track Courts in India - An Empirical Study". The call for following positions is released:

The incumbent to the positions listed above must possess the following qualifications:

A. Research Assistant and Field Investigators

Qualifications:

- (i) In case of Research Assistant and Field Investigators they must possess at least a graduate degree in Law with minimum 55% marks from any recognised institution.
- (ii) They are also expected to have some experience of handling data collection and exposure to the field work specially relating to court. Apart from assisting desk work in the project, they shall be primarily required to travel extensively in connection with data collection in the various Fast Track Courts located in different states. Those who have reservations for field work, please do not apply.

B. Project Coordinator

Qualifications:

The Project Coordinator should also have a minimum graduate in Law. However, a master degree and higher education in law shall be highly preferred. The incumbent should be highly proficient in legal research relating to judicial process and justice administration. They are expected to have demonstrated evidence of engagement in research work through published material. The duties for this position will involve the planning and coordination to research and also the visits to field locations for data collection work.

The applicants will submit an original write up of around 2500 words on the issue of Fast Track Courts showing their analytical skills.

Note: Duration for Research Assistant and Field Investigator will be initially for 6 months and extendable up to 12 months.

Application Process: The application to the above positions together with CV and other information must reach to the undersigned on the following email cev@nludelhi.ac.in. Only shortlisted candidates would be called for the interview. Anticipating the number of applications, it may not be possible to individually inform the outcome of their application separately.
