Greetings from CTAG

The Centre emphases on sensitizing people on transparency and accountability in governance; empowering people such as students, lawyers, and public officials to contribute effectively to ensure transparency and accountability in governance; and creating and promoting quality research in the area of transparency and accountability in governance. The Centre also provides, free of cost, for training, sensitization and consultative services on RTI to people. The Centre has organised national and International Conferences on good governance issues.

Centre for Transparency and Accountability in Governance (CTAG) of National Law University Delhi is inviting applications for Internship to law students for research and publication of assignments on Transparency and good governance

Period of Internship

The maximum period of internship is two months and minimum is one month.

The total internship period is divided into three slots

- Ist Internship Period: 1st May, 2017 30th May, 2017.
- IInd Internship Period: 1st June, 2017 30th June, 2017.
- IIIrd Internship Period: 1st July, 2017 31st July, 2017.

Certificates and other incentives will be provided on successful completion of the internship period. The interns are allowed to attend without any charges anyone event/seminar/workshop of the CTAG held during the academic year of internship.

Number of position

There are five positions. The CTAG may increase or decrease the number of position at any stage.

Removal or termination of intern

In case the quality of the research assignment is found to be unsatisfactory, the interns will be removed with proper justification. In such a situation another intern may be engaged and if required additional time period may also be provided.

Eligibility

Intern must be a law student from a recognised law school/university/college in India

Past experience in research and publication on any of the following area:

Good Governance

- Right to information
- Judicial Accountability
- Combating Corruption
- Public Services
- UN Convention Against Corruption
- Whistle Blower
- Ombudsman
- Public Interest matters

Duties and Responsibilities of the Intern

- It is expected that the intern must have research aptitude and good communication and writing skills
- The Centre will have a copyright over research assignments produce during the internships.
- Students engaged in the internship shall submit an undertaking for time bound completion of the assignment.
- Interns will not be allowed to do simultaneous internship at any other organisation.
