WINTER COURSE ON

Comparative Law in the Global South: Methodological Challenges and Issues of Identity Formation

National Law University Delhi in collaboration with Università degli studi della Campania "Luigi Vanvitelli" (formerly Second University of Naples) is organising a winter school from $10^{th} - 17^{th}$ January, 2018 on *Comparative Law in the Global South: Methodological Challenges and Issues of Identity Formation*. The course is designed primarily from the perspective of South and South Asian countries in which scholars from India, Italy, UK, Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore, Bangladesh, Greece and a few other countries are participating. Broadly, it includes the following heads for discussion:

- Comparative Law in the Global South: Methodological Challenges
- Federalism, Multiculturalism and Language Issues
- Legal Education and its Challenges
- Presentation of *The Indian Yearbook of Comparative Law 2016*
- Comparative Law and Justice in South and South East Asia: Methodological and Practical Challenges
- Law and Identity Construction
- Educating the Nation: Special Panel on educational challenges in India, Past and Present in interdisciplinary perspective

For each topic, prominent resource persons from India and abroad will participate. The course is being organised primarily for young scholars including those who are pursuing their PhD. The participants will be required to make short presentation on their specialization or the topic for their PhD, as the case may be. The main purpose of the course is to help young scholars in providing fresh insights to their research interests, particularly in the context of Global South. In order to make the programme effective and personalised, the number of participants is restricted to 20 in all.
