Area of work: CLJD is currently engaged in projects relating to human rights, gender justice, education and tribal rights. Pursuant to these research activities, CLJD is looking for interns to perform the following tasks:

- i. provide research support for ongoing projects;
- ii. research and compile information on specific areas and topics, when needed;
- iii. assist in documentation and preparation of project reports and Centre publications;
- iv. provide logistical and administrative support for Centre activities and initiatives; and
- v. assist with other related tasks as needed

Eligibility Requirement: Prospective applicants must possess the following qualifications:

- students currently enrolled in five-year/ three-year LL.B degree or LL.M or fresh graduates/post graduates intending to gather work experience;
- ii. demonstrate good research and writing skills;
- iii. demonstrate good oral and written communication skills; and
- iv. good knowledge of MS office and online platforms

Application Requirement:

- i. Curriculum Vitae, not exceeding two side A-4 sheet;
- ii. Statement of Purpose (max 350 words);
- iii. Writing sample; and

Duration: Four to six weeks; extendable with mutual consent on the basis of performance.
