National Law University Delhi has been ranked the Third (3rd) cleanest Higher Educational Institutions in the country by MHRD.

This award was in the category of **Government Residential Universities**. This category only includes five universities across the country.

The award was felicitated on 3rd December 2019, at Prajnan (Auditorium), AICTE, New Delhi. MHRD Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank announced the rankings, and that 6900 institutes participated in the rankings.

The HEIs were ranked in 9 different categories including residential and nonresidential government and public institutions.

Two NLUs were declared amongst the top five cleanest universities, including NLU Delhi at third and RGNUL Patiala at first.
