The endeavor of the University will be to impart knowledge in various aspects of law and to introduce the young generation of lawyers to a wide range of opportunities in legal profession. The University has state of the art infrastructure and facilities at its campus for learning and research at Sector 14, Dwarka, New Delhi.

The University invites applications for a five year integrated B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) degree programme for the academic year 2010-2011 commencing from August, 2010.

**FIVE-YEAR B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) PROGRAMME**

<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	Senior Secondary School Examination (10+2 System) or equivalent Examination with not less than 50% of marks in the aggregate (those who are appearing in the examination in March/April, 2010 can also apply)
<b>AGE LIMIT</b>	Below 21 years as on 1st July, 2010 (23 years in case of SC/ST candidates)
<b>TOTAL SEATS</b>	80 (eighty) [70 (Seventy) seats on merit through All India Entrance Examination and 10 (ten) seats for direct admission to Foreign Nationals on merit]. Foreign Nationals to be eligible should have 65% marks in the qualifying examination.
<b>RESERVATION</b>	15% for SC Candidates, 7.5% for ST Candidates, 3% for Persons with Disabilities.
<b>SCHOLARSHIPS</b>	The University provides liberal financial assistance for the needy and deserving students.

Admission will be strictly on merit through All India Entrance Examination to be conducted at **Ahmedabad, Bangalore, Chandigarh, Chennai, Cochin, Delhi, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Jammu, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai and Patna on 02.05.2010**. If sufficient number of applications are not received for a centre, the University reserves the right to cancel the said centre and shift the applicants of that centre to another nearest centre. Interested candidates may apply for admission on the prescribed format of application available on the University website: <http://nludelhi.ac.in> along with a Demand Draft of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) for General Candidates, Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) in case of SC, ST and Person with Disability (PD) drawn in favour of **“REGISTRAR, NATIONAL LAW UNIVERSITY, DELHI”**, payable at Delhi along with copies of requisite Caste/PD Certificate. **There is no application fee for Below Poverty Line (BPL) applicants of SC/ST category (copy of BPL certificate from competent authority to be enclosed with application)**. Note:

- (i) The candidate shall secure minimum of 40% (30% for SC and ST candidates) of the total marks in the All India Entrance Test to become eligible for the admission. The University has a right to keep the seats vacant if there are no candidates who secured minimum cut off marks.
- (ii) If two or more candidates secure the same percentage of marks in the Entrance Test, their merit will be determined on the basis of % of marks in the Intermediate Examination (10+2)/ Higher Secondary School or its equivalent recognized by the University.
- (iii) If the merit remains the same, then the marks of X standard will be taken into consideration. If still there is no change in rank, then the higher in age shall get preference.
- (iv) At least 30% of the total seats shall be filled by eligible horizontal reservation for women candidates including those selected in reserved and foreign national categories.

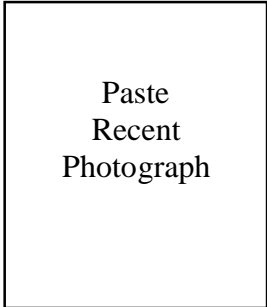
