The journal aspires towards becoming a vehicle for serious academic legal writing across the board. The journal will comprise of articles on critical legal issues highlighting the current development and trends in Indian legal system. The aim of the journal is to be of relevance to the bench, the bar, the academicians as well as the students.

CALL FOR PAPERS

The NLU Student Law Journal is now accepting submission for its first issue (VOLUME 1, ISSUE 1). The Journal encourages the contribution of Articles, Essays, Notes and Comments (Case Comments, Book Comments, Legislative Comments, Policy Comments and Scholarship Comments) from the members of judiciary, scholars, academicians, researchers, practitioners, policy makers and students of law and other members of legal fraternity.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

The NLUD Student Law Journal requests that the contributors comply with the following guidelines:

Submissions: The Journal is accepting contributions for Articles, Essays, Notes and Comments (Case Comments, Book Comments, Legislative Comments, Policy Comments and Scholarship Comments). Contributions should be mailed only in a soft copy to nslj.nlud@gmail.com, the subject of the mail being 'Submission for NSLJ'.

All submissions are to be made via e-mail as .docx documents (preferably Microsoft Word 2007 or 2010). All contributions should be original and should not be simultaneously considered by any other publication and co-authorship to a maximum of two authors is permitted.

The Journal accepts contribution for publication on a rolling basis throughout the year and the last date for submission for the First Issue is November 25th, 2010. Submissions made thereafter shall be considered for publication in the next issue.

Anonymous Review: As regards to our anonymous review process, the author's name, affiliation, biographical information is to be provided in a removable title page. Please include the manuscript's title on the first text page.

Length Limitations: With reference to Articles, contributions should range from 12000-15000 words. Essays and Notes should range from 6000-8000 words and Comments should range from 3500-5000 words.

Citation Format: The Journal encourages the use of footnotes and not end-notes as a method of citation. The Journal follows the Blue Book: A Uniform System of Citation (19th ed.) style of referencing. Contributors are requested to comply with the same. The main text of the paper should be in font size 12, Times New Roman, 1.5 line spacing and footnotes in font size 10, Times New Roman, 1.0 line spacing.

Plagiarism: All the contributions should be the original work of the contributors and should not have been submitted for consideration in any other Journal. Any plagiarised work will be out rightly rejected.

Copyright: The contributions presented to and accepted for publication and the copyrights therein shall be the intellectual property of the Law Journal.

Indemnification: All contributors, by submitting the papers towards the Law Journal, agree to indemnify the National Law University, Delhi and NSLJ from and against all claims, suits, and damages based on any claim of copyright infringement or plagiarism or unauthorized use.
